

**MOJAVE** is an American DJ and producer who specializes in soulful house and dark techno, drawing inspiration from the beauty and decay of Southern California's Mojave Desert. A multi-instrumentalist with a foundation in classical, jazz and music theory, formal training in sound design and production, she brings a sharp ear, unique sound and open mind to the decks.

Mojave has performed top nightclubs, festivals and the underground circuit throughout the U.S. and Europe, headlining Berlin's famed Suicide Circus and SchwuZ, supporting the likes of Sasha and Skream at Minimal Effort festival (L.A.); DVS1, Volvox, DJ Hyperactive, Paul Johnson, Woody McBride at the legendary Even Furthur festival; Radio Slave, The Advent at 6AM x INCOGNITO (L.A.); John Tejada at The Liquor Store (Portland); Kerri Chandler, Sonny Fodera, CamelPhat, Coyu, Mark Kinchen, Prok & Fitch, Harvey McKay, Noir, Danny Howard at Exchange (L.A); Matt Lange at Clinic Wednesdays (L.A.); Tijana T at FOCUS (O.C.); Francesca Lombardo, Chus & Ceballos at La Cave. Internationally, she holds a residency on FNOOB Techno Radio (London) and appears regularly on prominent radio shows like Data Transmission, Barcelona City FM, KXLU FM, and others in the U.K., U.S., Germany, and Canada. She serves as a social media manager for female:pressure, a Berlin-based international collective advocating for women-identifying and non-binary artists in electronic music. Locally in Los Angeles, she is a resident DJ at MDA's La Cave and PANIC, and a regular performer at ExchangeLA.

Her passion for discovering and sharing new music began as a kid growing up in Boston, exploring her parents' vinyl collection and digging in local record shops. After spending her formative years playing in orchestras and Boston's punk/hardcore scene, she moved to Los Angeles and New York and found herself quickly immersed in both cities' dance music scenes. Her love for house and techno, and the warm social inclusion of these communities—the idea of the dance floor as a safe haven—inspired her to become a DJ, producer and event organizer to bring people together and promote these values.

Influenced by her classical training and upbringing on metal, classic rock, hip-hop, post-rock and ambient music, Mojave delivers exciting, genre-blurring live sets and compositions, moving fluidly between classic and soulful house, jackin' techno and dark techno, ethereal ambient stretches and breaks. As music continues to evolve, she is on top of it while staying true to the roots, selecting fresh, diverse, emotionally evocative tunes that elevate the energy of the room, fill the dance floor, and keep audiences guessing. With a busy international gig schedule and new productions on the way, 2020 is looking bright for Mojave.
